First Academy Dress Code Policy 2025-2026

First Academy strives to provide an environment where clothing choices do not distract from learning. The dress code which follows is intended to be a practical, simple, and standardized expression of the principles of modesty, decency and appropriateness. 1 Timothy 2:9; 1 Peter 3:3-4 Students dressed in this manner will not wear clothing that is gaudy or provocative and will avoid extreme styles in either clothing or appearance.

Dress Code: Preschool and Pre-K

Dress your child in loose and comfortable clothes that are washable. Jeans, shorts or pants are preferable for girls because many of our activities are on the floor. If your child wears a dress or skirt, shorts or leggings must be worn underneath. We will spend some time outside each day, weather permitting. Be sure that your child has warm clothing for cold days. **Be sure to label all coats, sweaters, hats, etc., with your child's full name.** Wednesdays are chapel days, and so to encourage reverence, we ask that boys wear collared shirts and khaki shorts/pants, and girls are asked to wear skirts/dress.

Dress Code General Guidelines: K-10th Grades (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday)

Tops:

- Collared uniform-style polo shirts must be solid color (white, gray, navy, or light blue) with no design or designer logos. *FA LOGO REQUIRED
- Button down solid color shirt (white or light blue) *FA LOGO REQUIRED

Pants:

- Uniform dress pants, chino, and docker style pants from any retail source may be worn.
- The following colors are allowed: navy, khaki, or black
- Leggings are not to be worn as pants.

Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers, and Dresses (Girls):

- Uniform skirts, skorts, and jumpers from any retail source may be worn.
- The following colors may be worn: navy, khaki, or black and Lands End Clear Blue Plaid.
- *FA LOGO REQUIRED on solid jumpers.
- Skirts, jumpers and dresses must reach or be lower than the fingertips and may not be excessively tight.
- Please wear shorts or tights under skirts, dresses, and jumpers for modesty.

Shorts:

- Uniform and Dockers style shorts in solid colors, navy, khaki, or black from any retail source may be worn.
- Shorts must reach or be lower than the fingertips and may not be excessively tight.

Shoes/Leg Wear:

- Appropriate styles of shoes include athletic shoes, dress shoes, sandals, and boots.
- Leggings are not to be worn as pants.

Outerwear/Jackets/Sweatshirts (Boys and Girls):

- Any solid navy, gray, light blue, or white sweater, pull over, button or zip style jackets with no promotional logos, designs or writing.
 *FA LOGO Optional
- Hoods are not permitted while indoors.

Dress Code: Fridays & other designated casual days K - 10th Grade

Bottoms options

• Any uniform-style bottoms, jeans, or jean shorts (no cut offs or rips in jeans).

Top options

- First Academy t-shirt or sweatshirt, any Christian, church related, or shirt with scripture ex. Awana, VBS, or plain colored t-shirts
- First Academy school t-shirts are available in many styles, fabrics, and colors. They are available for purchase several times throughout the year through fundraising.
- No other school t-shirts or sports teams (Except on Spirit Days)
- Other t-shirts will be approved for special events (fundraiser t-shirts, special events, team spirit days, etc.)

Pants/Dresses/Shorts/Skirts:

- Must be free from rips and holes that show skin, frays, tears, cuts, and graffiti.
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must reach or be lower than the fingertips and may not be excessively tight.
- Leggings may be worn with mid-thigh length tops.
- Pants must be worn at the natural waist and cannot be poorly fitted, oversized or baggy to allow sagging of the pants.

Shoes/Headgear:

- Shoes must be worn at all times. Appropriate styles of shoes include athletic shoes, dress shoes, sandals and boots
- Bedroom shoes are not allowed.
- Hats are not allowed.

Dress Code: 11th and 12th Grade Dual Enrollment Students

Dress code applies to full time students and will not apply to students who leave campus to attend dual enrollment classes. <u>If students are on campus and attend chapel, the following dress code will be enforced:</u>

- Boys must wear a dress shirt (button up the front or polo) with dress pants and belt.
- Shirts do not have to be solid.
- Shirts with FA Logos are acceptable, but not required.
- Girls must wear a dress, skirt or dress pants.
- No jeans
- No hats

Prohibited Garments at First Academy:

- Shirts with revealing or low neckline; strapless shirts; form fitting or tight tops; see-through tops; no outside layering of tube tops, spaghetti straps, or shirts with inappropriate language or design. All shoulders should be at least 3 closed fingers wide.
- Shoes with heels higher than 2 ½ inches, flip flops, bedroom shoes, and distracting or inappropriate footwear (or as deemed by the Head of School).
- Hats, hoods, sunglasses and other forms of headwear are not allowed to be worn except on designated school spirit days.
- Exaggerated hairstyles are not permitted (or as deemed by the Head of School).

Dress Code Violations:

- 1st Offense: verbal warning to the student
- 2nd Offense: written warning to the parents/guardians
- 3rd Offense: Call to parents to bring appropriate clothing

Habitual violation of dress code may result in In-School Suspension, Out of School Suspension, or possible expulsion.
